
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Old windslab accumulations will continue to consolidate. Greatest accumulations will remain around coire rims on South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. There will be a redistribution of snow leading to new accumulations of windslab developing on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Where new accumulations gain depth instabilities will develop but these will be mostly isolated and avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Some light snowfall is expected overnight, this will clear to leave a dry day. South-West to Westerly winds will increase from moderate to strong. During the night the freezing level will rise towards summit levels briefly before falling later to 900 metres.
