
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of windslab will develop on Easterly to Southerly aspects above 900 metres. Instabilities will be present where accumulation gain depth; however these will be generally isolated and avoidable. Areas most affected will be around the tops of some gullies and coire rims. Elsewhere the remaining old snowpack will be firm well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers will turn heavier for a spell during the night and early morning, these will turn lighter before petering out by the afternoon. Strong South-South-Westerly winds will veer to the North-North-West during the morning. The freezing level will fall from 900 to 700 metres.
