

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Significant drifting will lead to new accumulations of unstable windslab developing on North-West to North-Easterly aspects. On these aspects this will be most widespread above 800 metres where avalanches are likely particularly in areas of steep terrain. Other aspects will be affected by cross loading. Unstable cornices will develop in these areas. Localised instabilities will also develop on steep banks and shallow gullies below 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light Southerly winds will steadily increase through the night to gale force before easing to strong and veering to the South-West during the day. The arrival of snowfall is expected overnight, this will turn lighter and more showery through the afternoon. The freezing level will be around 600 to 700 metres.
