

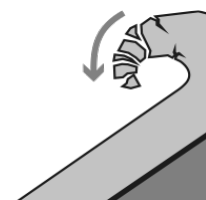

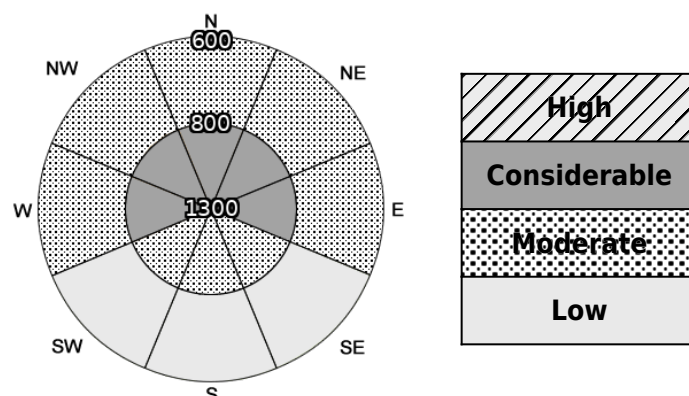
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting snow, this will be more severe during the afternoon. Unstable windslab will continue to develop and mostly affect West through North to East aspects above 800 metres; here avalanches are likely especially in areas of steep, wind sheltered terrain such as the tops of gullies, coire rims, and crag aprons. More localised instabilities developing below 800 metres on steep banks and shallow gullies. Fragile cornices will continue to develop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mainly dry up until mid afternoon, before the arrival of persistent snowfall above 400 metres. Strong West-South-Westerly winds will ease, back to the South-East then steadily increase through the day strong becoming storm force through the afternoon.

Comments

Significant drifting expected, this will increase through the afternoon.
