

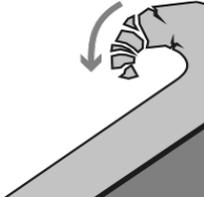



#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deep accumulations of unstable windslab will become more widespread on South-West through North-West to Northerly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches will occur. Steep wind sheltered terrain will be particularly affected. Unstable windslab will develop on similar aspects between 800 and mostly above 400 metres on steep banks and shallow gullies. Cross loading will also affect many other aspects with unstable accumulations. Cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be High.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall will continue for the duration of the forecast period, this will be heavier during the night. Strong to gale force East-South-Easterly winds will back to the North-East during the day and ease moderate to strong. The freezing level will be mostly around 700 metres.

#### Comments

Poor mountain conditions over the next 24 hours.
