





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

With the onset of snow showers and moderate winds overnight, some limited windslab instability is expected where newly drifted snow achieves depth, on mainly very steep North to Easterly aspects above 850m. Some new small cornice development around coire rims of these aspects. Good stability on less steep ground, at lower altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming slightly cooler with the FL lowering to around 600 metres accompanied some by light snow showers throughout the period, with snow lying to around 300 metres. Moderate Westerly winds overnight, becoming more West-South-West by day-break.
