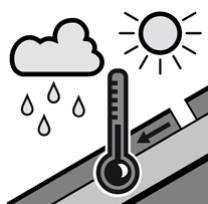
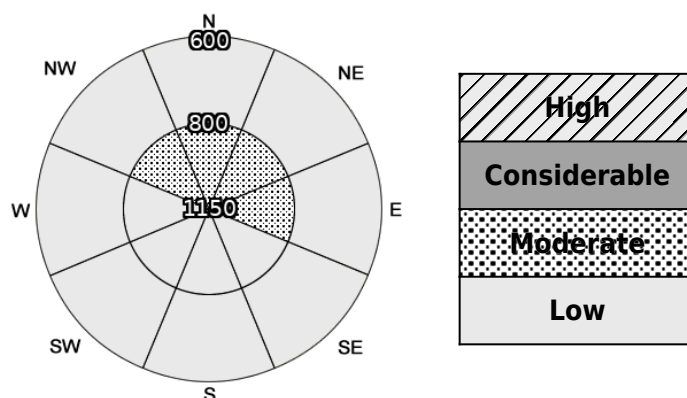


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 11/12/2021****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Some limited surface instability is expected later in the period on steeper terrain as the freezing level rises above the summits. Localised, moderately bonded windslab will be encountered in wind sheltered locations on North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A cold and dry night followed by some limited snowfall around day break. This will turn to light rain as the freezing level rapidly rises to well above all summits. The overnight North-Westerly winds will back and increase in strength during the morning to become strong Southerly.
