### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 13/12/2021


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fluctuating temperatures; the old snowpack will continue to consolidate in all locations and remain well bonded and stable throughout. New windslab accumulations will develop mainly around coire rims and gully tops on North to East aspects above 900 metres. These are expected to be generally shallow, isolated and avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Light rain is expected at all levels during the night on gale force gusting storm force Southerly winds. Cooler during the day with occasional light snow showers on strong to gale force South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will fall to around 800 metres during the early hours of the morning, it will remain at this level for the duration of the forecast period.

#### Comments

Snow cover becoming patchy below 800m.
