
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will freeze and consolidate in the colder conditions. Through the day fresh areas of windslab will be deposited on mainly North to East aspects above 1000 metres. These areas are not expected to be deep, and should be generally avoidable. The tops of slopes and gullies will be most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

After a mild spell early in the night the freezing level will drop to around 800 metres where it will remain through the day. There will be some snow showers throughout the day. Winds will be from the South-West.

Comments

Outlook generally mild, thaw conditions expected after Tuesday.
