
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in most locations. A little new windslab will begin to form on steepest N to E aspects above 800m. Most new accumulations will be thin and limited in extent. Deeper deposits possible around coire rims and gully tops by the end of the day. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight rain turning to snow showers in the early hours which will continue for the rest of the day. Very strong S winds overnight easing progressively and becoming WSW. Mild overnight, freezing level falling to 750m during the day.

Comments

Snowfall in showers. Medium to low confidence in forecasted snow amounts.
