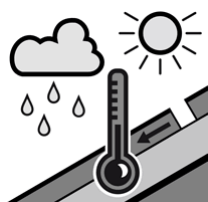


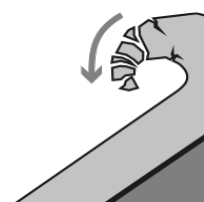

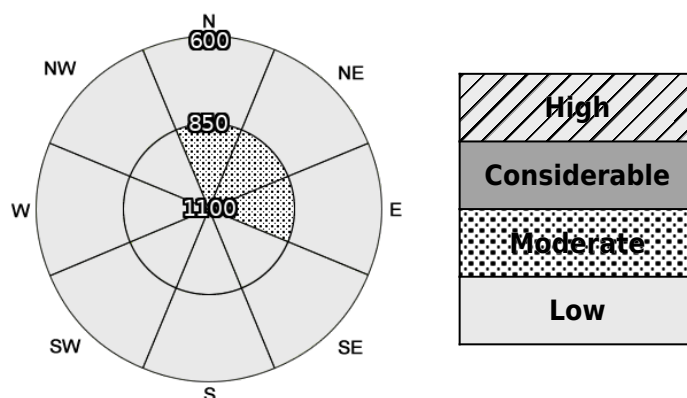
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Where recent localised accumulations have achieved depth, in sheltered mainly North to East aspects around coire rims above 850m, wet snow instabilities will exist for a period; particularly with the arrival of rain. Elsewhere the snowpack although moist will be generally well bonded in most locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snow showers will turn to rain again in the early hours and continue for the rest of the day. The strong South-West airflow will strengthen progressively overnight and persist throughout the day. Freezing levels will rise rapidly to well above the summits at first light
