



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 15/12/2021

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and diminish overnight. The snowpack will be moist, but well consolidated and generally stable in all areas, becoming firmer at higher elevations towards the end of the forecasting period. Greatest accumulations will be on North-West through North to North-Easterly aspects above 900 metres, with only patchy cover below this altitude. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above the summits overnight, then steadily lower to around 1200m. Overnight rain will clear to leave a mostly dry day. Storm force South-Westerly winds will gradually ease to strong, and veer West-South-West.

Comments

Snowpack will continue to thaw and diminish overnight, becoming firmer as the freezing level drops below summit level. Possible threat from stone fall beneath cliffs during the thaw
