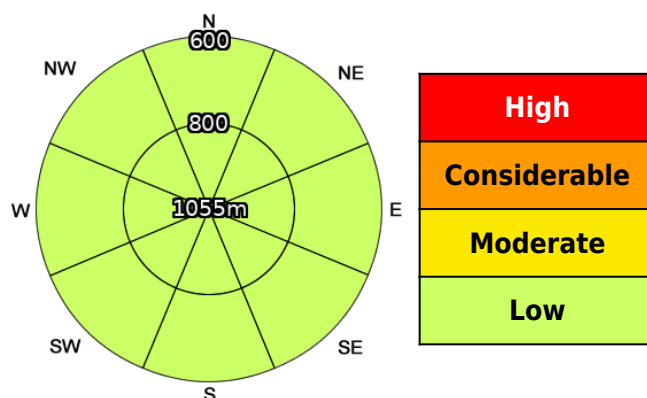


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 15/12/2021****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected. The diminishing and patchy snowpack will remain wet and thawing at all levels and will have generally good stability throughout. Little snow remains below 600 metres, whilst most snow exists above 800 metres, on North through East to South-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be a band of rain at all levels overnight, followed by a largely dry day but with persistent hill fog. Less cloud is expected on the more inland mountains. The South-West gales will gradually moderate, becoming more Westerly during the day. The freezing level will remain above the summits.

Comments

Remaining unseasonably mild. High pressure conditions will dominate by the end of the week.
