


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 15/12/2021**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will initially be soft and moist with generally good stability on all but the very steepest slopes and gully exits where surface wet snow instabilities will exist. A return to drier and cooler conditions through the day will aid the consolidation process in all areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Mild and wet conditions will continue overnight affecting all levels. It will become drier and cooler through the morning with the freezing level lowering to around 1200 metres by the end of the day. Strong to gale force winds overnight will moderate through the course of the day and will be mainly from a West-South-Westerly direction.

**Comments**

Mild and quite wet conditions are expected overnight with a return to dry and cooler conditions on Wednesday.
