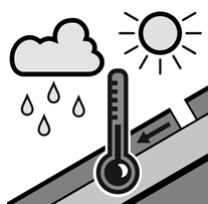
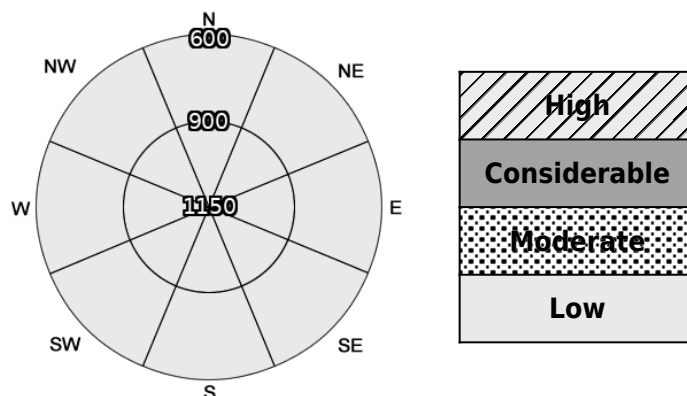


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 17/12/2021****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The patchy snow cover will continue to thaw but will remain well bonded throughout. Some surface instabilities possible on sun affected slopes. Greatest amounts will be on North to East aspects above 900 metres, below this altitude cover will be very patchy. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

High pressure conditions are forecast to build. It will remain dry with any cloud expected to clear, giving a mostly sunny day. Temperatures could be as high as 10 to 13 celsius on the tops during the day but falling to zero quickly after sunset. Winds light and variable.

Comments

Likely to feel very mild tomorrow with summit temperatures possibly as high as 10 to 13 degrees celsius during the day.
