

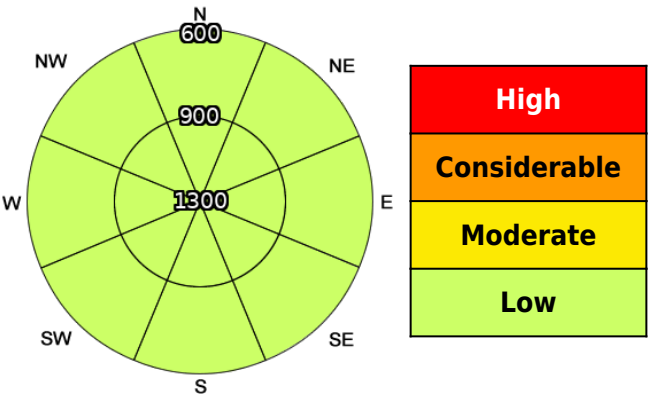

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 19/12/2021

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain firm well bonded and stable in all locations. Some softening of surface layers on sun exposed slopes. The old snowpack is most widespread on some West through North to South-East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure with inversion conditions will continue to dominate the highlands. The freezing level will remain well above the summits but it will be much colder with freezing temperatures at lower altitudes. Skies will be clear and winds will be light and variable.

Very firm snowpack with serious run out potential into rocks below.
