The limited snowpack will be firm and stable throughout. Greatest amounts can be found on North to East aspects above 850 metres. Very little snow below 700 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**High****Considerable****Moderate****Low****Forecast Weather Influences**

Fresh winds from the South-East will gradually decrease to light and back to become South-Westerly. Clear skies are forecasted with the freezing level initially above the summits but dropping to 800 metres in the afternoon.

Comments

Noticeably colder at lower levels today with verglas present on paths and ice forming on lochans and water courses.
