



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 20/12/2021

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snow will be firm, well bonded and stable throughout. Cover will be patchy with largest areas being found on North and East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Whilst high pressure will continue to dominate, a weak cold front will slowly push into the area, resulting in the cloud inversion lifting to around summit level. Remaining dry. Winds will be generally light, slowly veering from the North, through East to South. Sub zero air temperatures becoming established overnight on the summits.

Comments

Snow surface is firm and icy with poor run-outs. Water-ice on paths and tracks.
