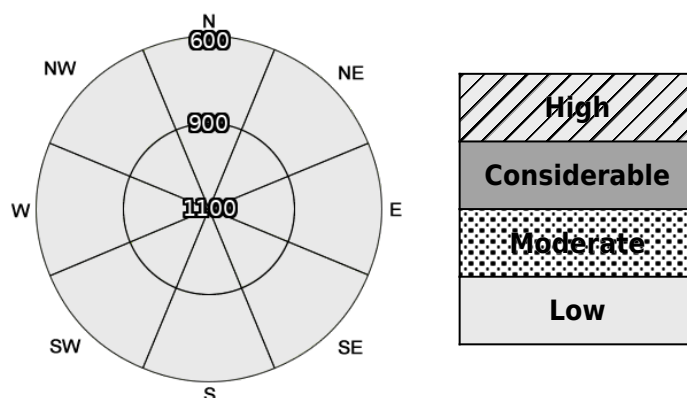
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy old snowpack will remain hard and stable. A little thin new windslab is possible on steep North-West to North aspects above 900m very late in the afternoon but accumulations are unlikely to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold overnight. Less cold than during the day. Threat of some sleety snow showers very late in the forecast period. Light to moderate South-South-East winds by the afternoon.

Comments

Limited snow cover; mainly sparsely distributed patches of old hard snow.
