



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 23/12/2021

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snow patches will be firm and well bonded. Limited, fresh accumulations will start to form at the end of the period in wind sheltered locations on South through West to North-West aspects above 1000 metres. Deposits are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Sleet during the early evening will die out to give a mostly dry night. Rain will return at daybreak, turning to sleet at 900 metres and light snow at 1200 metres during the afternoon as the freezing level starts to lower. Light overnight winds will increase in strength to become fresh East-North-Easterly.

Comments

Freezing levels set to lower on Thursday afternoon with some further limited snow forecast for the evening.
