

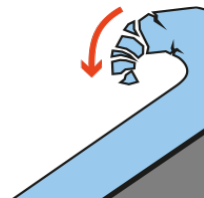

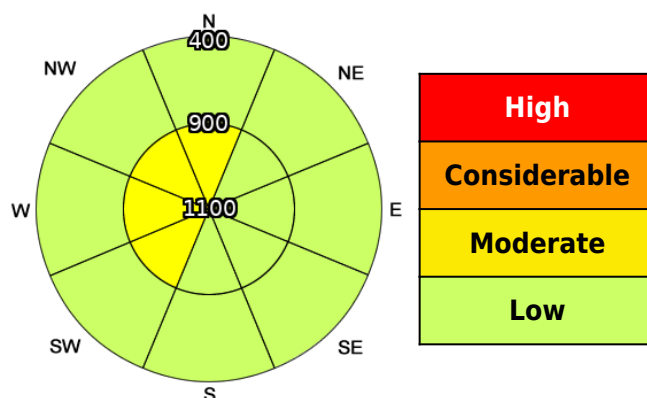
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in all wind exposed locations. Stronger winds will redeposit snow as deeper more extensive, weaker windslab mainly on steep SW to N aspects above 900m. Very steep lee slopes, coire rims and gully exits will be particularly affected. New cornice development also expected above these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Becoming persistently colder. Much stronger ESE winds.
