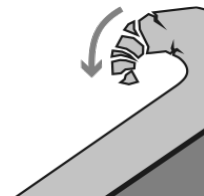
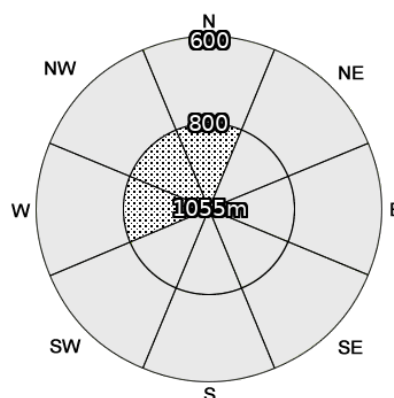

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wind exposed aspects will continue to scour with some wind slab instabilities building depth and extent on high West through North-West to Northerly aspects above 800 meters. These accumulations while isolated will mainly affect wind sheltered coire rims, ridge crests and the tops of gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.


Forecast Weather Influences

Strong East-South-East winds will continue, with little precipitation expected. The freezing level will remain low.
