

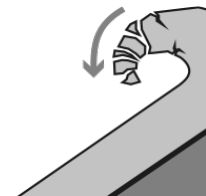

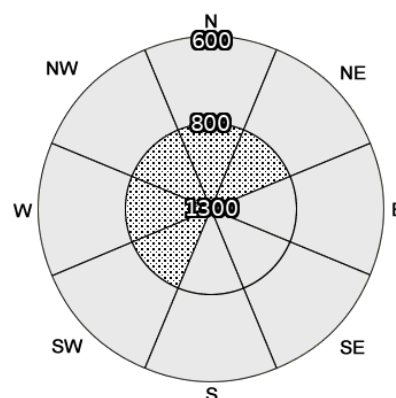

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Mostly the landscape is wind scoured and bare with only a thin snow cover in many places above 600 metres. However, very weakly bonded windslab will be present in wind sheltered places. Especially affected will be gully exits, coire rims and ridge flanks on mostly West to North aspects above 800 metres, these areas are not extensive but are significantly poor in stability. SW and NE aspects also affected due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Storm force South-South-Easterly winds will persist through most of the the forecast period ut lessening to gale force later. A mostly dry day is expected but some light snow showers possible late in the afternoon.

Comments

Although limited in extent the unstable windslab areas are significantly poor in stability.
