Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will very slowly become more moist but should remain generally well bonded and stable. However, some isolated wet snow instabilities may start to develop where older shallow windslab existed mainly on steep West to North aspects above 950 metres with gully exits and corrie rims most affected. These are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

Forecast Weather Influences

Mostly dry with the freezing level at around 1000 metres. Light, East-South-Easterly winds will back becoming North-Easterly and eventually North-Westerly by the end of the day, staying relatively light.
