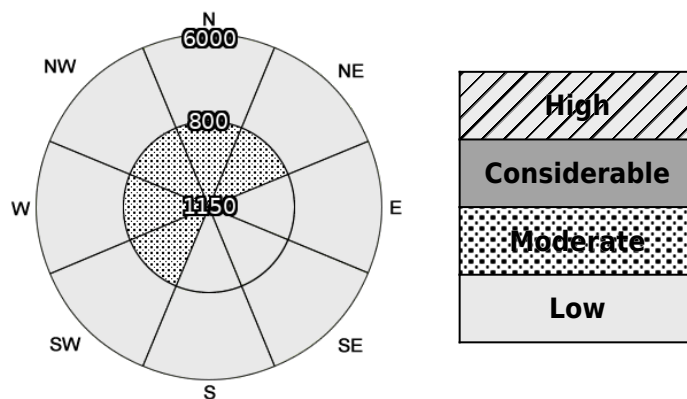
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will persist, mainly in steep, wind sheltered locations on West to North aspects above 900 metres. Isolated areas of windslab will also be present on South-West and North-East locations. Elsewhere there will be a shallow covering of wet snow on most aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will lift to around the highest summits for all of this forecasted period. Likely to be a cloudy day but there will be no significant precipitation. Winds will be moderate to fresh, initially East-North-East, backing to the North-West by afternoon.
