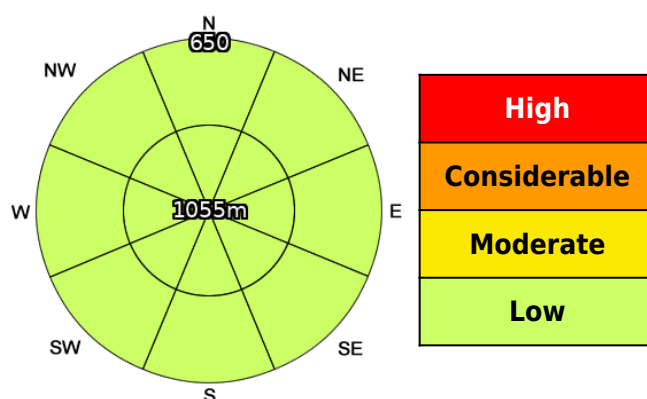


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 29/12/2021****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The limited snow cover will thaw at all levels through the day, diminishing, particularly at lower elevations and will have good stability throughout. A dusting of fresh snow likely in the morning, but amounts will not be significant, before thawing later. Exposed areas of old snow will remain firm. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Dry overnight, with light rain at all levels periodically through the day, preceded by a little sleet and summit snow in the morning. The freezing level will rise from 600 metres overnight to well above the summits by mid morning. A light Southerly wind overnight will strengthen and back Easterly by midday, veering strong to gale force South-Westerly by the end of the period.

Comments

Expect milder conditions and more unsettled weather over the next few days.
