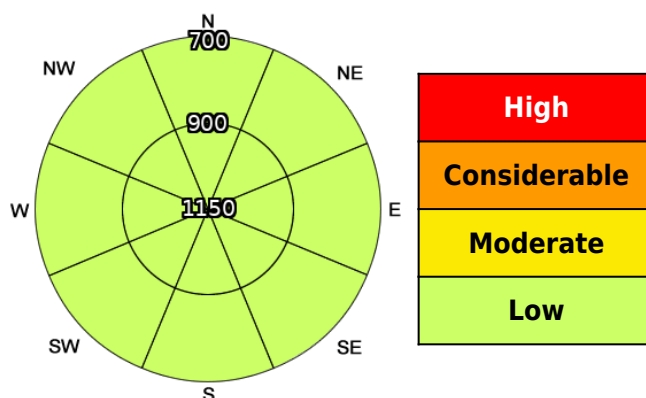
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow cover will continue to thaw and soften with isolated instabilities possible on steep terrain but otherwise remaining snow will be well bonded and stable. Greatest amounts of snow will be above 900 metres, below this altitude cover will be very patchy. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing mild with the freezing levels above the summits. Likely to be cloudy with possible light rain at times. Overnight the winds will ease, backing to the East, remaining light and variable during the day.
