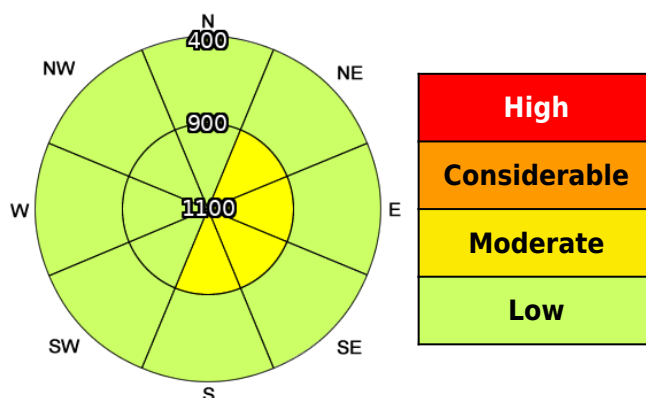

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Early thin, humid windslab development expected West to North aspects above 950m. Later cold, softer, windslab will form on steep North-East to South aspects above 900m; poorer stability in these places but only where windslab achieves depth, mainly at gully exits and steep coire rims. Minor new cornice development above steepest lees slopes. Good stability in all other locations and altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Sleety snow showers overnight then much colder with snowfall down to most altitudes during the early morning. Strong West-South-West winds but easing quickly during the day and becoming West-North-West, later North.

Comments

Much colder temperatures expected from Monday morning onwards.
