




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be significant drifting with new accumulations of windslab developing on North-East through East to Southerly aspects above 800 metres. Greatest instability will be where accumulations gain depth within steep wind sheltered areas such as below coire rims, the tops of gullies and crag aprons. Isolated windslab will develop on other aspects due to cross loading. Fragile cornices will begin to develop. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers at all levels on strong to gale force North-Westerly winds. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.

Comments

Very cold conditions with drifting snow expected.
