

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow instabilities will exist in areas of cold, weak new windslab which will continue to develop on steep East to South aspects above 800 metres. Some cross-loading will also occur in steep, sheltered North-East facing gullies and around coire rims. Any new cornices in these areas will be weak. Good stability in all wind-exposed locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Further snow showers, heavy at times will die away overnight. It will remain cool with Freezing levels around 200 metres throughout. The strong North-Westerly airflow will moderate by first light.
