Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present, mainly on North-East through South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Wind sheltered locations, corrie rims, gully tops and scarp slopes will be particularly affected. Also here, fragile cornices will be starting to build. Otherwise, there will be a covering of dry unconsolidated snow with the odd deeper drift down to low levels. Exposed terrain will be scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.
