




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some localised snow instabilities will develop at the highest elevations on steep, sheltered North-West to North-East facing gullies and around coire rims above 950 metres. Any new cornices in these areas will be weak. Good stability in all wind-exposed locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold overnight before a rising freezing level will bring outbreaks of snow turning to rain below 800 metres. South-West winds will increase during the day to strong South-Easterly.

Comments

Fluctuating temperatures with a mixture of hard icy ground and occasional soft new snow patches. Recent accumulations have not been significant
