




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to develop in wind sheltered locations such as coire rims, gullies and crag aprons with greatest accumulations on North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres, West and South-East aspects will also be affected due to cross loading. Fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. Localised instabilities will also be present on steep banks and gullies at lower elevations and above 550 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight showers will clear to give a cloudy dry day. The freezing level will drop from 750 metres to around 200 metres by the morning. Moderate to strong West-South-Westerly winds will veer Westerly during the morning.
