


Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow and wind transport of existing deposits will form weakly bonded windslab in sheltered locations such as summit gullies and on North-West through North to South-Easterly aspects mainly above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Fresh cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Frequent snow showers will affect the area for much of the period. Winds will be strong to gale force mainly West South Westerly. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.

Comments

Possibility of hail and thunder exists for the Westerly ranges.
