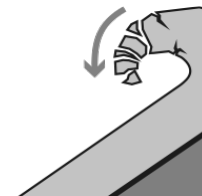
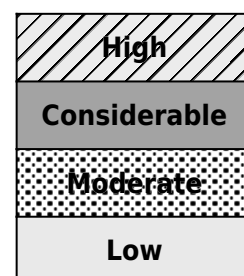
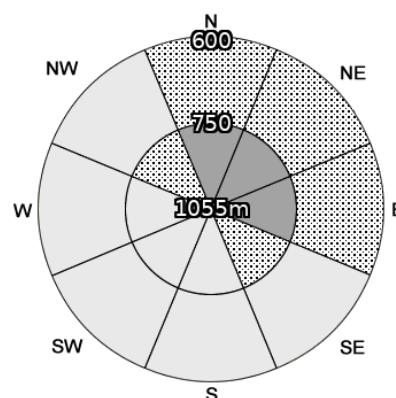

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be drifting in the strong winds. This redistributed and fresh snow will build areas of unstable windslab, especially where it gains depth in steep locations, on North-West through North to East aspects above 750 metres. Cornices will develop on the same aspects. Wind exposed aspects will scour and the snowpack on these slopes will become firmer although some previous cross loading instabilities will linger. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable


Forecast Weather Influences

There will be strong West-South-West winds with heavy snow throughout the period. The freezing level will lower from 500 meters this evening to around 380 metres.

Comments

Good snow cover remains from around 250 meters upwards. A return to winter.
