

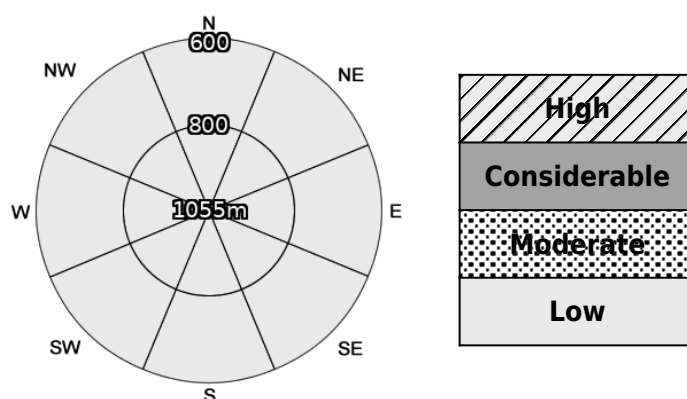

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 11/01/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing wet snowpack will freeze and consolidate in the colder conditions overnight and will be generally stable. Fresh windslab deposits, mainly on North to East aspects above 800 metres, are expected to be isolated and shallow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-west winds and occasional showers. The freezing level will drop to around 600 metres overnight and then rise to 1000 metres during the day.

Comments

Wednesday and Thursday mild and mainly dry with strong West-South-West winds.
