



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 12/01/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain firm, well consolidated and stable in all areas. Greatest accumulations will be on North-West through North to East aspects above 900m. Below this altitude, the snowpack will continue to thaw and diminish. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will initially be around 1000m, rising to well above the summits for the rest of the forecast period. The wind will be gale force occasionally storm force, from the West-South-West. A dry day is expected, with only occasional light snow showers at the start of the forecasting period.

Comments

The snowpack has diminished and then refrozen. Remaining snow is firm with serious run out potential.
