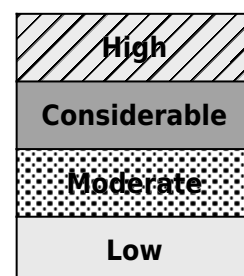
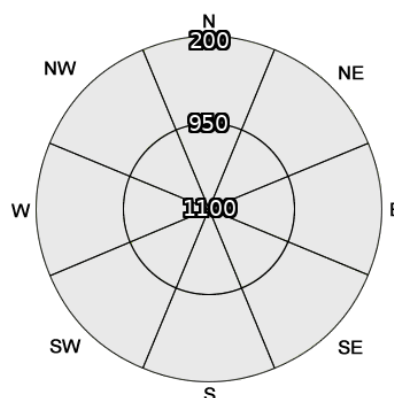
Wet Snow



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in most places and altitudes. The snowpack will become wet but remain generally well bonded. Some limited, shallow wet snow instability is possible on very steep North to East aspects above 950m with the onset of rain. All cornices will become progressively weaker. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Progressively milder; freezing level rising to above summits overnight. A few light overnight snow showers then light rainfall until noon. Moderate to strong WSW winds.

Comments

Falling ice observed from crags below 850m in Coire Ardair on Tuesday. Falling ice and rocks expected to remain potential hazards in the immediate vicinity of steep crags throughout Wednesday.
