

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 14/01/2022**


**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The remaining moist snowpack will continue to thaw and diminish at all levels. Stability will be generally good in all locations. Any remaining cornices will be soft and unstable. Greatest snow accumulations will remain on North to East aspects above 850 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will become increasingly patchy. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Some light overnight rain will clear to give a mainly dry but cloudy day. Moderate West-South-Westerly winds will become light and veer South-South-West by dawn. The freezing level will be above the summits.
