


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 15/01/2022

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and remain well bonded firm and stable throughout. Greatest accumulations will be on North-West through North to East facing coire back walls, ridge flanks and plateau areas above 900 metres. Below this altitude the ground will be mostly bare with ribbons of soft stable snow remaining in areas such as shallow gullies and steep banks. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions will continue throughout the forecast period. Moderate South-South-Westerly winds will steadily increase overnight to become strong South-Westerly during the day. Cooler temperatures are expected as the freezing level falls to around 700 metres.

#### Comments

Serious runout potential into rocky terrain on some steep slopes. Rockfall also a potential hazard.
