



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 16/01/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Quantities of new snow are not expected to bring about any significant change. Stability will remain good. The existing accumulations of snow, which lie primarily above 800 meters on North through to Easterly aspects will be re-frozen, hard and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Fluctuating temperatures overnight with a little precipitation, falling as rain, then snow above 800 metres. The Freezing levels will lower again by daylight to around 600 metres. Fresh West-South-West winds will ease West-North-West before, increasing moderate Westerly as the day progresses.

Comments

Ground above 850 metres hard underfoot. Cool on the tops.
