
Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Mon 17/01/2022 TO 18:00HRS Tue 18/01/2022



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probabilty
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry with the odd shower of light rain or drizzle later on Tuesday. Winds will be fresh to strong South or South-South-Westerly. The freezing level is expected to remain above the summits.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack stability will generally remain good with a firm and icy surface persisting at higher elevations. Greatest accumulations will be in sheltered gullies and in the higher Northerly and Easterly corries, mainly above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

Observed Weather Influences

Dry, settled conditions have affected the area, the freezing level is above the summits, winds have been generally South-Westerly moderate to fresh.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack remains firm with some surface softening on sun exposed slopes. Greatest accumulations are in sheltered gullies and on Northerly and Easterly aspects mainly above 850 metres. Stability is generally good. The avalanche hazard is Low.

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions	Firm snow with some softening in the warm sunshine. 40% of low cloud cover at mid-day. Winds approx 10 - 20 mph.
Comments	Surface of snow will remain firm icy in sheltered locations and at higher elevations.
