



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Small accumulations of new drifted snow will form in steepest wind sheltered Easterly aspects. Although these are not expected to be significant where any depth is achieved above 800 metres moderately bonded new snow instabilities will exist. Elsewhere the old patchy deposits will be well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

It will become cooler overnight with some rain showers turning to snow as the Freezing Levels lower to around 200 metres. Strong South-Westerly winds will become North Westerly by first light.
