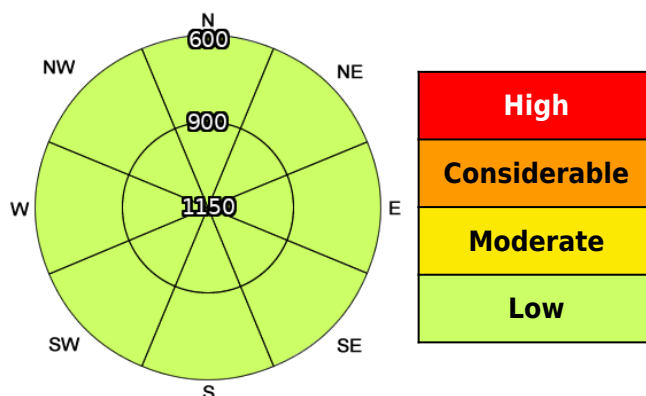

Little change is expected. There will be a new dusting of snow around the summits with older patchy snow remaining hard and well bonded throughout. Greatest amounts of snow will be found on North to East facing aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A cold night is expected, the freezing level will be around the glens but will rise during the day to around 800 metres. Very light snow showers are expected overnight but it will be dry during the day. Winds, moderate in strength, mostly North-Westerly.
