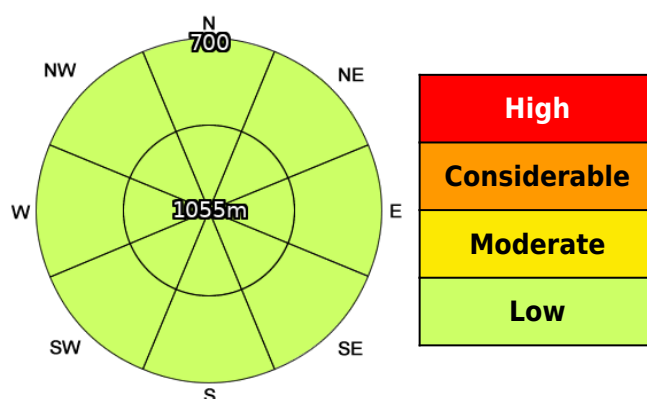


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 21/01/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The dusting of new snow will gradually thaw at all levels through the day, the snowline rising to near summit level by the end of the period. Otherwise, the patches of older snow will be well consolidated and stable throughout, softening at lower elevations, but remaining firm around the summits. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a largely dry and cloudy day. The cloud may be thick enough at times to give some patchy drizzle. The wind will be generally Westerly, freshening through the day. Overnight, the freezing level will steadily rise to, and remain at, summit level or above.

Comments

Little change into the weekend; remaining relatively mild, cloudy, light rain at times. Widespread gales on Sunday.
