



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 22/01/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will remain well bonded and stable at all altitudes. The greatest amounts will be found on North-Westerly through North to Easterly aspects above 950 metres, particularly around coire back walls, ridge flanks and plateau areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions are expected throughout the forecast period. Moderate to strong winds will be West-South-Westerly in direction. The freezing level will remain above the summits.

Comments

Although mild, the snowpack remains firm with serious run out potential onto rocks below.
