


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 23/01/2022

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack will be well bonded and stable at all altitudes. Greatest amounts will be found on North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 950 metres, especially around coire back walls, ridge flanks and on the plateau. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry throughout the forecast period with strong to gale force South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will be above the summits overnight before it turns cooler during the day.

#### Comments

Although mild, the snowpack is firm at higher levels with serious run-out potential into rocks below.
