



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 24/01/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack will remain well bonded and stable at all altitudes. The most widespread patches will be found on North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 950 metres, around coire back walls, ridge flanks and on the plateau. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions are expected to continue. Gale force South-Westerly winds will gradually ease through the night to become strong then moderate West-South-Westerly during the day. The freezing level will fluctuate at around the highest summits.
