
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack stability will remain good in all locations. Snow cover will be limited and patchy with greatest accumulations in the higher North and Easterly corries. The surface of much of the snowpack will begin to soften as rain and milder conditions take effect. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be above the summits for the period. A moist South-Westerly flow will bring some light overnight rain or drizzle followed by a mostly dry day, some rain due again by late afternoon. Winds will be strong West-South-Westerly.
