


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 25/01/2022**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

New snow amounts are not expected to be significant mainly a dusting over the highest summits. The old patchy snowpack on mainly North to Easterly aspects above 850 metres will remain generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will be around 1400 metres with some precipitation forecast for the afternoon falling as light snow above 1000 metres. Winds will be fresh South-South-Westerly strengthening through the day with widespread hill fog.

**Comments**

Widespread hill fog tomorrow, colder conditions forecast for Thursday.
